**Social Worker II-Family Caregiver Support**

Incumbent will identify needs of unpaid family caregivers that are providing personal care for a family member or disabled adult (18 years or older). Duties include providing information and assistance, referrals, coordinating support groups and caregiver trainings as needed. Incumbent will conduct interviews, conduct assessments, and listen to concerns regarding health, safety and nutrition in order to offer appropriate services.

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:**

- Knowledge of principles and practices of social work.
- Knowledge of customer services techniques.
- Knowledge of team building concepts.
- Knowledge of technical program development methods and techniques.
- Knowledge of Tribal contracting principles and techniques.
- Knowledge of terminology, laws, rules and regulations governing area of assignment.
- Ability to adhere to confidentiality requirements of client records which includes: federal, state, and tribal confidentiality policies.
- Ability to complete the Required TCARE assessor training/certification.
- Ability to work with a variety of clientele and diverse populations.
- Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing with Aging and Long Term Support Administration (AL TSA), government agencies other professionals and the public.
- Ability to comply with laws, codes, ordinances, and regulations.

**General Recruiting Indicators:**

- Minimum of a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work, Social Sciences, Gerontology, Psychology, Counseling, or related fields and two years social science experience.

**Special Requirements:**

- Required to pass a pre-employment drug and alcohol test.
- Required to pass a pre-employment background check.
- Must possess or have ability to obtain a valid WA State Driver License and Tribal driving permit. Must submit a driving abstract for the past 5 years at time of application.
- Required to complete a DSHS background Inquiry authorization (DSHS 09-653). Appointment to position is subject to the results of the background inquiry.
- Required to complete the online DSHS HIPAA Privacy Training upon hire.
- Required to complete DSHS IT Security Awareness Training upon hire annually.
- Required to complete the DSHS TCARE Assessor Training and become certified within 3 months of hire or as soon as offered by DSHS.
- Must have the ability to travel within Washington State to attend required trainings as needed.
